Conflict of Interest Resolution

A “conflict of interest” is designated to occur when an individual, who has a financial relationship with a commercial entity, has the opportunity to affect CME content that concerns the products or services of the commercial entity. CME providers must insure that conflicts of interest are disclosed and resolved prior to offering a Category 1 activity.

Conflict of Interest is not applicable: the content of my presentation is not related to products or services provided by commercial entities with which I have a significant financial relationship.
